## JOB PURPOSE:

The postholder will work as an integral part of the Grounds and Gardening Services Team, performing horticultural, landscaping and maintenance duties across the University Estate. He/she will also be required to work on University sports facilities when required. The post holder will work 37 hours over 5 days per week (which may include Saturday working).

#### **MAJOR DUTIES:**

- 1. Undertake a range of horticultural duties, such as planting, pruning, propagation, seeding, grass-cutting, weed control, maintenance of plants and the preparation of external floral displays etc, working within an established process.
- 2. Undertake tree/shrub planting and maintenance of hard/soft landscaping, including fine and sports turf (natural and synthetic).
- 3. Assist in the erection, maintenance and dismantling of equipment for major events e.g. garden parties, Graduations, sporting events etc. Liaise with event organisers as appropriate.
- 4. Operate specialised powered tools, both electrical and engine driven, including hand-held, pedestrian-operated tools, ride-on and tractor-mounted engines, e.g. cylinder mowers, aeration equipment.
- 5. Undertake routine operator maintenance of all grounds equipment and machinery.
- 6. Undertake external cleaning of all litter, empty bins, clear leaves, debris, snow and ice from roads, paths and grounds.
- 7. Carry out minor arboriculture duties such as crown raising of trees and dealing with fallen tree limbs.
- 8. Comply with all relevant Health and Safety procedures, and ensure safety on work sites, safeguarding self, colleagues, students, and any other users of the University.
- 9. Undertake the setting out, maintaining, painting and marking of all sport pitches and areas.
- 10. Carry out any other duties which are appropriate to the post as may be reasonably requested by your Supervisor.

## **ESSENTIAL CRITERIA:**

- 1. Secondary School Education.
- 2. Certificate of Competence in Pesticide Application (PA1, PA6a).
- 3. Minimum of two years' recent relevant Horticultural experience.
- 4. Relevant experience with rose beds and herbaceous borders.
- 5. Relevant experience with soft landscaping, floral bedding schemes etc.
- 6. Ability to communicate well with other team members; QUB management and customers.
- 7. Interest in practical outdoor work.
- 8. Self-starter and the ability to work on his/her own initiative.
- 9. Good Team member.
- 10. Full valid driving license (shortlisted candidates will be required to provide a copy of their driving license prior to interview).
- 11. Post will involve irregular hours and a degree of flexibility in duties including a rota for weekend working.
- 12. Must be prepared to work unsociable hours.

- 2. Relevant experience with Sports Turf maintenance.
- 3. Tractor operations (e.g. Verti-drain, seeder and top-dresser)including attachments.
