### JOB PURPOSE:

To provide technical support within a laboratory environment for teaching and research purposes.

#### **MAJOR DUTIES:**

- 1. Operate a glass washing and autoclave facility to provide clean glassware and carry out sterilization procedures for teaching and research. Process and/or dispose of various categories of lab waste in line with specified established procedures.
- 2. Operate equipment/apparatus for research and teaching purposes following clear direction from senior technical staff.
- 3. Provide assistance with the setup and clear away of laboratory practical classes. Assist with preparation of materials for practical classes and research.
- 4. Carry out basic equipment/apparatus maintenance following routine instructions.
- 5. Maintain general cleanliness and tidiness in both the prep room and laboratory areas.
- 6. General movement and transportation of goods and equipment in line with health & safety and manual handling procedures.
- 7. Monitor levels of stocks and ensure that equipment and work areas are ready to use when required. Identify requisite materials to ensure availability to meet work requirements.
- 8. Carry out routine record keeping including the recording and filing of information and maintenance of straightforward databases.
- 9. Contribute to general security of premises and integrity of laboratory operations and comply with all Health & Safety Requirements.
- 10. Carry out any other duties which are appropriate to the post, as may be reasonably requested by Senior Technical Staff.
